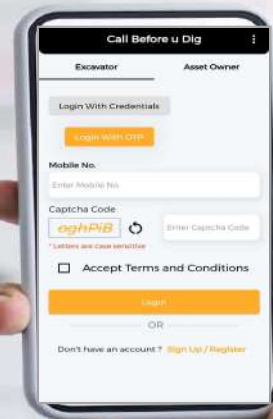

## “Call Before u Dig” Mobile App



### **Introduction:**

Various agencies often undertake excavation activities and many times underground utility assets get damaged.

This may be due to lack of knowledge of excavation agencies about existing utilities or lack of coordination with utility asset owner agencies.

### **Objective:**

To provide an interface and communication channel between TO

- Excavation / Digging agencies
- Utility Asset Owners

To coordinate for proposed excavation/digging activities and to safeguard existing underlying utility assets like Optical Fibre Cables, Water Pipelines, Electric Cables, Gas Pipelines etc. from damages.



## Features-Call Before u Dig (CBuD)

“Call Before u Dig” CBuD - Mobile and can be downloaded on App android & iOS devices.

Excavator can submit excavation/digging plan and know contact details of utility asset owners for coordination before start of excavation.

Utility Owners – will get details submitted by excavators about excavation activity, know contact details of excavator and interact with them.

Excavators/utility asset owners will be given alerts via SMS, email and in-app notification and will also have the facility of ‘click to call’.

App will ensure connecting all the appropriate utility authorities and diggers to the electronic platform.

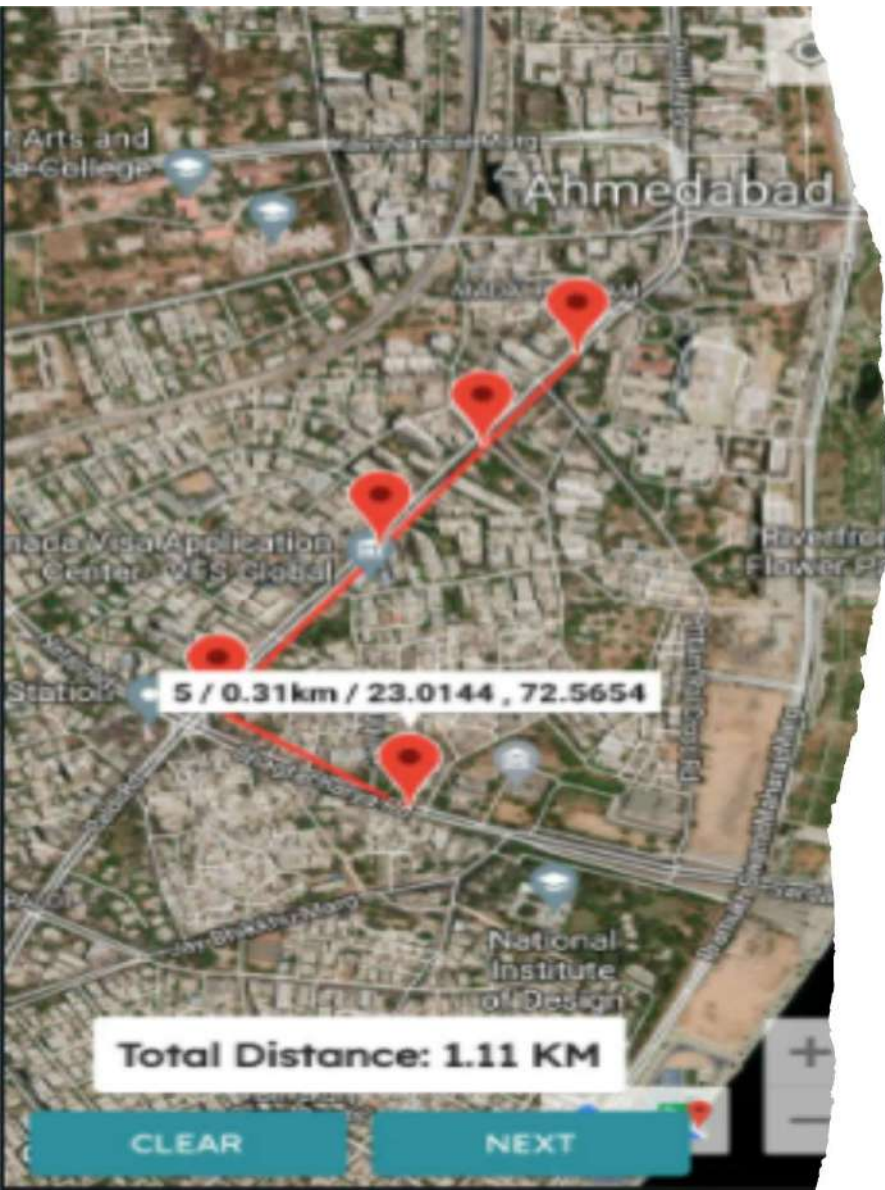
App will allow scheduled digging and uniformity of processes.

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The diggers can easily navigate on map for register digging information . He can mark the location of digging.

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Total distance of digging will be shown on map.

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Owners of all the utility assets can come to know about imminent digging by any agency around their utility assets and take precautionary measures viz. do flagging on ground around their utility assets, before the actual digging and coordinate with digger

## Responsibility of States/ UTs

- (1) All underground utility/asset owner agencies viz. Electricity Cables, Water-pipe, Gas-pipe, Sewerage etc. to be directed by State /UT Govt:
  - to map contact details/ escalation matrix in the **“Call Before u Dig” App** for receiving SMS/email notifications.
  - to be mandated to respond to messages from **“Call Before u Dig” App** and take actions accordingly, even if they have mapped or not mapped their assets.
  - to register their assets on PM GatiShakti NMP
- (2) All digging agencies to be mandated by State / UT Govt:
  - to do any type of digging only after prior intimation through **“Call Before u Dig” App** and as per its terms and conditions.
  - to use the App before commencing any type of digging anywhere in the State / UT.
- (3) All State /UT departments to be directed to include Point 2 in the approval letter format, while granting approval for any type of digging anywhere in the State.

भा.सा.वि. 06(अ).— केन्द्रीय सरकार, भारतीय तार अधिनियम, 1885 (1885 का 13) की धारा 7 द्वारा प्रदान की गई शक्तों का प्रयोग करते हुए, निम्नलिखित नियम बनाती है, अर्थात्:-

1. संक्षिप्त नाम और शीर्षक:- (1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम भारतीय तार (अवरोधन मुक्ति) नियम, 2022 है।

(2) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2. परिभाषा:- (1) इन नियमों में, जब तक कि संदर्भ से अन्यथा अपेक्षित न हो, -

(क) "अधिनियम" से भारतीय तार अधिनियम, 1885 (1885 का 13) अभिप्रेत है;

(ख) "साधन पोर्टल" से इन नियमों के अंतर्गत के लिए केन्द्रीय सरकार द्वारा विनियमित और अतिरिक्त पोर्टल का संदर्भित अर्थ उपरोक्त अभिप्रेत है;

(ग) "अनुमतिधारी" से अधिनियम की धारा 4 की उप-धारा (1) के अंतर्गत अनुमति प्राप्त करने वाला कोई व्यक्ति अभिप्रेत है;

(घ) "मुक्ति" से साधन पोर्टल के माध्यम से प्रस्तुत की गई धारा 4 का उप-धारा (1) के अंतर्गत मुक्ति अभिप्रेत है;

(क) "तार अवरोधन" से तार या तार साधन और पोस्ट शामिल हैं;

(2) इन शब्दों और पदों के जो अनुक्रम हैं और परिभाषित नहीं हैं किन्तु अधिनियम में परिभाषित हैं वही अर्थ होंगे जो अधिनियम में हैं।

3. किसी संघीय की धुराई या उपभोग के विधिक अधिकार का प्रयोग करने की प्रक्रिया - (1) कोई व्यक्ति जो किसी संघीय के अधिकार के विधिक अधिकार से धुराई या उपभोग की रक्षा इस प्रकार से रक्षा हो जिससे कि अधिनियम के उपबंधों के अनुसार संचयन रूप से स्थापित की गई तार अवरोधन या टेलीग्राफिक संचार को नुकसान पहुंचाने या बाधित करने की संभावना हो, तो वह व्यक्ति ऐसे अधिकार का प्रयोग करने से पूर्व इस प्रकार की धुराई या उपभोग की मुक्ति, साधन पोर्टल के माध्यम से प्रस्तुत करने अनुमतिधारी को मुक्ति देगा।

(2) उप-नियम (1) के अंतर्गत मुक्ति से विधिक अधिकार का उपयोग करने वाले व्यक्ति का नाम और पता, एजेंसी का स्वरूप, पता, धुराई शुरू करने की तारीख और समय, धुराई का विवरण और स्थान तथा इस प्रकार की धुराई या उपभोग करने के कारण शामिल किए जाएंगे।

(3) अनुमतिधारी उप-नियम (1) के अंतर्गत मुक्ति प्रस्तुत करने पर संघीय से संबंध किसी भी अनुमतिधारी द्वारा स्थापित बाधों या निर्धारित या तार अवरोधन का स्वरूप साधन पोर्टल के माध्यम से तथा सीधे उपर्युक्त कानूनी विधायक प्रयोग वह तार अवरोधन को धारित धुराई बिना संचयन के लिए पूर्णतः स्वतंत्रता के साथ-साथ अधिकार के विधिक प्रयोग के लिए करना चाहता है।

(4) धुराई या उपभोग के विधिक अधिकार का प्रयोग करने वाला व्यक्ति, उप-नियम (3) के अनुसार अनुमतिधारी द्वारा किए गए पूर्णतः स्वतंत्रता के तहत पर उपर्युक्त धुराई करेगा।

(5) यदि कोई अनुमतिधारी अधिनियम की धारा 19(क) के अनुसार विहित सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र में स्थापित नहीं करता है तो धुराई या उपभोग के विधिक अधिकार प्राप्त व्यक्ति इसके परंपरागत संघीय की धुराई या उपभोग करने के लिए स्वतंत्र होगा।

4. नियम के उपबंधों के अंतर्गत के लिए मुक्तानी प्रचार - (1) कोई व्यक्ति, जिसने किसी संघीय की धुराई या उपभोग के विधिक अधिकार का प्रयोग इस रूप से किया हो, जिससे अधिनियम के उपबंधों के अनुसार विनियमित रहे या तार अवरोधन के मुक्तानी शर्तों को नुकसान होता है, वह तार अधिकारी को मुक्तानी प्रचार का मुताबिक करने के लिए उत्तरदायी होगा।

(2) उप-नियम (1) के अंतर्गत मुक्तानी प्रचार की शर्तों के अन्तर्गत पर की जाएगी और मुक्तानी के प्रचारार्थन में उत्तरदायी किया जाए।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 3rd January, 2023

G.S.R. 06(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 (13 of 1885), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, namely: -

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Indian Telegraph (Infrastructure Safety) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions. —(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, -

(a) "Act" means the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 (13 of 1885);

(b) "common portal" means a portal or mobile phone application developed and notified by the Central Government for the purposes of these rules;

(c) "licensee" means any person holding a license under sub-section (1) of section 4 of the act.

(d) "notice" means prior information of digging or excavation submitted through common portal.

(e) "telegraph infrastructure" includes a telegraph or a telegraph line and post.

(2) Words and expressions used and not defined herein but defined in the Act shall have the meaning assigned to them in the Act.

3. Procedure for exercising of legal right to dig or excavate any property. — (1) Any person desiring to dig or excavate in the legal exercise of a right with any property in such a manner as is likely to cause damage to a telegraph infrastructure or to interrupt or interfere with telegraphic communication which has been duly placed in accordance with the provisions of the Act, shall give notice to licensee through common portal, by submitting the information of such digging or excavation, prior to the commencement of such exercise.

(2) The notice under sub-rule (1) shall include the name and address of the person exercising the legal right, agency details, contact details, date and time of start of the exercise, description and location of the exercise, and the reasons for such digging or excavation.

(3) The licensee shall, on submission of notice by the person under sub-rule (1), as expeditiously as possible provide through the common portal, the details of telegraph infrastructure owned or control or managed by such licensee, falling under or over or along the property with which the person intends to deal in legal exercise of the right, along with precautionary measures for coordination in avoiding damages to the telegraph infrastructure.

(4) The person exercising legal right to dig or excavate shall take appropriate action on precautionary measures provided by the licensee as per sub-rule (3).

(5) In case no licensee provides details within the prescribed time as per section 19(A) of the Act, the person having legal right to dig or excavate shall be free to dig or excavate the property thereafter.

4. Damage charges for breach of provisions of the rule. — (1) Any person, who in exercise of legal right has dig or has excavated any property in such a manner causing damage to a telegraph infrastructure duly placed in accordance with the provisions of the Act shall be liable to pay the damage charges to the telegraph authority.

(2) The damage charges under sub-rule (1) shall be computed based on such expenses as may be incurred in restoring damages.
